

# HOW TO GET FROM BELGRADE NIKOLA TESLA AIRPORT TO THE CITY CENTRE

Nikola Tesla, Belgrade airport is not big, so if you are arriving on international flights there is only one main exit terminal and exit gate. You cannot mistake it. At main exit gate you can find taxi, bus service or meet your limo driver. Distance from Belgrade airport to the city centre is about 20 km. The trip takes around 30 minutes by car or 45 minutes by bus (Line 72 and A1).

## 1. AIROPORT TAXI SERVICE

Belgrade taxi service is cheap, but be careful. Sometimes, taxi drivers operating from the Belgrade Airport heavily overcharge clients. In order to stop this bad practice, the Belgrade Government has introduced the following mechanism for getting a taxi at the exit terminal of the Belgrade Airport.

Just on the airport exit there is a Taxi information desk, where you can ask for the taxi voucher to wanted destination and it's always the fixed price. So, from the airport to the city centre the price is around 1800 dinars (18\$). You just have to say the address to the Taxi information desk officer (Belgrade Main Bus Station). They will give you a voucher with fixed price and will be going with you right to the first available taxi driver and you are paying that amount when you get to the desired address.



Taxi drivers usually do not accept credit card payments, so have some cash with you (small Euro banknotes or get dinars at ATMs or exchange office at Airport). Taxi service operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year. The picture below shows Taxi information desk (5 meters left from main exit gate at Nikola Tesla Airport).

## 2. BUS SERVICE - MINI BUS A1

Second option is the public bus service, by Mini Bus A1. Tickets can be purchased in the bus and the cost is 300 dinars (3\$). From [Slavija Square](#) (the last stop of mini bus A1), you can either walk to your destination or use the public transport (bus, tram, trolley bus...). Public transportation is very cheap, but could be crowded at peak hours, so if you have a lot of luggage it could be a problem.



Bus Station on Belgrade airport for Mini Bus A1 is easy to find, just exit glass door on arrival terminal and turn left and walk 15 meters. The picture below shows bus station on airport exit terminal.

Mini Bus service operate from 5 am. Last bus leave airport at 18:40 pm. Time table and route for bus A1 (Line Belgrade Airport – Slavija Sqare).



### 3. BUS SERVICE - PUBLIC CITY BUS No. 72

If you like adventure you can also use Public City Bus No. 72. Public bus line 72 departs from the airport every 30 minutes starting from 5:20 till 00:00. It will take you through several parts of Belgrade before arriving at its final stop near the [Zeleni Venac](#) green market in the city centre.

Tickets can be bought from the vehicle’s driver (more expensive) or at kiosks market with a ticket sales sticker (BusPlus), and must be validated upon entering the vehicle.
